Social Skills Focus at MIPS

This fortnight's Social Skill is:

PATIENCE

- The way we act can have an impact on the way others see us, and a patient attitude is one of the key ways to achieve this.
- Having patience is one of the most valuable social skills a person can have that can help develop an individual from childhood into adulthood.
- Demonstrating patience with others shows the person that you are willing to give them time and respect their feelings and personal space.
- Giving an individual time to respond or by waiting your turn can have a dramatic effect in the response and way that you are treated and viewed.
- In the Christian religion patience is one of the most valuable qualities of life. As they always say 'patience is a virtue.'

<u>Parent Links</u>: There are many ways to teach children to be patient. You as a parent can choose ways that suit you as an individual and that fits your beliefs and values. Children learn from example and experiences, just like adults. Being calm and supportive when your child is upset or may have done something wrong is a good way to display patience. Being a good role model by explaining to your child calmly with reasons is a great way to demonstrate patience. Teach and demonstrate to your child the proper way to start a conversation, get someone's attention, or join a group of children who are already playing together. These are all situations that can be discussed and brainstormed at the dinner table, or in the car on the way to school or activities.

Tips for Buying/Selling

Can't find what you need? List a Wanted Ad – many sellers have located a buyer this way and do not need to proceed to writing a For Sale ad so trading often happens without even needing a listing!

Be patient, items are traded all year round. If it doesn't sell this season, it probably will the next. Check in during peak selling periods (seasonal changeovers and end of each school holidays) as this is when parents find items no longer fit and are looking to buy/sell.

Choose the item category of the uniform you are selling from the pre-populated list – this will see it more easily found when buyers are searching for an item. Price items For Sale reasonably, consider what you would be prepared to pay and utilise the pricing guide suggested in the creation of your advertisement based on the condition of the item. If items have been amended from original sizing (eg trouser or skirt hems adjusted) perhaps offer a "try before buy" option to ensure it is suitable for the next student.

Want to donate? This is fine, just list your items at \$0.00

Prefer Facebook? Your ad can be directly uploaded to Facebook. Click on the Seller Details on your advertisement and Share to Facebook on your newsfeed or in any group to maximise exposure. The second hand shop is designed to complement other buying/selling methods you may be using and ensures all families have access to and can participate in trading.

If you don't get a quick response to an enquiry, telephone the seller, many people do not check their emails regularly.

Remember to delist your Ads once they are no longer needed to avoid unnecessary enquiries.
