Dear Parents and Carers,

This week commenced of course with the feast of the Ascension of the Lord which is recounted in our reading from the Acts of the Apostles. Our gospel reading was then from Matthew 28:16-20.

"The eleven disciples set out for Galilee to the mountain where Jesus had arranged to meet them. When they saw him they fell down before him, though some hesitated. Jesus came up and spoke to them. He said, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commandments I gave to you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'"

Next week we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. We are inspired by the courage and conviction of the apostles and subsequent disciples to live out and proclaim the Good News. We see here in the actions of our early church founders a zeal to make known to others what they have learned from Jesus.

Clearly for them, their experience of Jesus changed them and the course of their lives. In a world where the Good News is as much in need of being heard as ever, it is each of us who have the opportunity to make the loving message of Jesus echo through our own lives and actions.
